- Completed application.
- One letter of recommendation.
- A personal statement up to 500 words on the topic: How resilience has helped me overcome personal challenges.
- High school transcript. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.

A. Eligibility:

The applicant must be a college-bound, graduating senior with a cumulative, weighted high school GPA of 3.0 or above and attend a high school in one of the following counties: Sacramento, Placer, Yolo, Yuba, Sutter, Alameda Amador, Butte, Contra Costa, Nevada, San Joaquin, Solano, or El Dorado. SAFE employees, volunteers, and immediate family members of employees or volunteers are ineligible to participate.

B. Amount of Award:

SAFE Credit Union is awarding ten (10) \$1,000 scholarships.

C. Application Information:

- 1. Applications are available in all SAFE branches, by mail or fax by calling (916) 979-7233, and online at safecu.org.
- 2. Completed applications must be emailed or postmarked no later than Wednesday, March 31, 2021.

D. Basis of Selection:

Scholarship finalists are chosen based on the following criteria:

- 1. Academic achievement
- 2. Financial need
- 3. Composition
- 4. Letter of recommendation

E. Completing the Application:

Please submit the completed application, one letter of recommendation written by an individual aware and supportive of your academic and leadership capabilities, a personal statement describing how resilience has helped you overcome personal challenges, and a high school transcript (unofficial transcripts will be accepted).
